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**Mathematics and metaphysics. A short comment on the hypothesis of the mathematicality of the world**

Summary

The paper presents the hypothesis of the mathematical rationality of the world put forward by Polish Platonist Michael Heller. There are two obstacles which make it difficult to understand this hypothesis. These are: (1) a conviction that mathematical entities are causally powerless and (2) a suspicion that mathematical objects, understood as ontological beings, are unintelligible.
